Associate Regents—Section VI

- A. Nominations for the Order of the Purple Cross may be made by an Associate Regent or Regent of the York Rite College of which the nominee is a member. Such nominations must then receive the unanimous approval of the Associate Regents and Regents of said York Rite College present at the time the vote is taken. An Assembly of the Distinguished Brothers of the Order of the Purple Cross shall be convened for this purpose. If there is a Regent or Regents in the membership of said York Rite College the senior Regent willing to preside shall convene the Assembly. If there is no Regent present from the membership of said York Rite College the senior Associate Regent willing to preside will convene the Assembly. Each College may annually nominate one (1) member for the Order of the Purple Cross. However, if the number of Associate Regents in a College comprise less that 10% of the total membership of that College, that College may nominate two (2) members for the Order of the Purple Cross. In making the above 10% calculation, Associate Regents who have plural membership in a College, but who received their Purple Cross through another College, shall count as a part of the total membership of the College, but shall not count as a part of the 10%. Further, Associate Regents age 80 and above shall count as a part of the total membership of the College, but shall not count as part of the 10%. Should a College allow their membership to fall below the constitutional requirement of 25 (Section 101, B) they disqualify themselves to submit a nomination for the Order of the Purple Cross. (7/06)
- B. The Grand Governor of each State or Province may make one nomination at large per year within his State or Province without regard to the limitations in Subsection A of Section 6. Such nominations shall be completely justified by the Grand Governor. All nominations originating with the Associate Regents in the State or Province are subject to the approval or disapproval of the Grand Governor of the State or Province in which is located the York Rite College, of which each nominee is a member, and may be submitted to the York Rite Sovereign College only by the Grand Governor, after his approval. All nominations originating with the Grand Governor are subject to the approval of the Board of Directors and may be submitted to the York Rite Sovereign College of North America only by the Board of Directors approval.
- C. In the States or Provinces not having a Grand Governor, nominations for the Order of the Purple Cross of York must be submitted to the
- Governor General, who is also empowered to nominate candidates in such jurisdictions.
- D. All nominations for the Order of the Purple Cross of York must be in the Detroit Office of the YORK RITE SOVEREIGN COLLEGE OF NORTH AMERICA no later than July 1 of each year, and must be accompanied by the appropriate form stating the qualifying reasons for the nomination. (7/00) All requests to grant late nominations for the Order of the Purple Cross will be denied by the Board of Directors since the Board of Directors has no authority to overrule a regulation adopted by the Regents. (7/97)
- E. Election of nominees to receive the Order of the Purple Cross of York shall require the unanimous approval of the Officers and Regents present at the General Assembly, and those elected shall receive the honor at the following General Assembly; except that by the unanimous approval of the Board of Directors the Order may be conferred upon a candidate at another time and place by a Regent or Associate Regent so designated by the Governor General. Any other deviation from the above procedure shall require the unanimous approval of the Officers and Regents.
- F. A candidate elected to receive the Order of the Purple Cross of York who fails to present himself at the General Assembly for which he is proposed, or the second year if granted a waiver, shall be dropped as a candidate. All nominees will be notified of this rule. (7/06)
- G. The fee to be paid to the YORK RITE SOVEREIGN COLLEGE OF NORTH AMERICA for the Order of the Purple Cross of York shall be such amount as shall be established by resolution of that Body from time to time.
- H. All required paperwork, registration and Purple Cross fees of the candidate must be received at the Sovereign College Office on or before January 31 of the year the candidate is to receive the Order of the Purple Cross. Failure to do so will disqualify the candidate. (7/06)
- I. A nominee to receive the Order of the Purple Cross of York shall not have his nomination approved by the Board of Directors if the Annual Return and Financial obligation of the College of which he is a member are not received at the Office of the Secretary General by July 1 of that year. (7/97)
